St. Croix County residents are highly skilled and educated. Just over 26% of the county's population (25 years and over) possess a Bachelor's Degree or higher; 81% are private sector wage & salary workers and another 7% are self-employed.

24% of the adult workforce is employed in the manufacturing sector and 7% are employed in professional, scientific, management, and administrative fields. Another 17.5% work in education, health and social services.
